- 7. Perform quantitative take-offs to verify estimates, order materials and price change orders.
- 8. Organize, coordinate, and schedule both deliveries and installations with our Installation Manager.
- 9. Lead Punch List activity, rectification, and project close out (including packaging of General Contractor's requirements for Close-Out Documents).
- 10. Develop and strengthen working relationships with vendors, general contractors, warehouse, and installation sub-contractors.
